NOMAD WINS NEW CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

Nomad Building Solutions Limited (**Nomad**) (ASX Code: NOD) wishes to advise that its wholly owned subsidiary Nomad Modular Building, has been awarded two additional contracts valued at \$9.8 million, to construct facilities for Rio Tinto's iron ore expansion projects in the Pilbara region of Western Australia.

The first contract valued at \$6.3 million is for the design and manufacture of 120 accommodation rooms and four laundries for the Western Turner Brockman Project. Design of the buildings has commenced and work is scheduled to be completed and the buildings delivered to site, by 30 September 2011.

The second contract valued at \$3.5 million, is for the design and manufacture of a range of camp buildings (including administration, communications and recreational facilities) for the Cape Lambert Port 'B' Project. Work on the buildings will commence immediately and is scheduled to be completed and the buildings delivered to site, by the end of October 2011.

Nomad's Managing Director Mr Michael Bourke said "that restructuring, new management and improved internal processes are strengthening the design, estimating, scheduling and project management capabilities of the business. The award of new contracts with mining companies over the past 3-4 months leaves Nomad Modular very well positioned to win a significant ongoing share of this type of work in the future".
